EMIRATES AIRLINE US OPEN SERIES BONUS CHALLENGE

The Emirates Airline US Open Series has awarded nearly \$8.4 million in bonus prize money since it began in 2004. Since 2006, Emirates Airline US Open Series bonus prize money allocations have been based on a permanent structured schedule (see below). The USA offers more than \$2.6 million in potential bonus singles prize money at the 2013 US Open to the top three men's and top three women's finishers in the Emirates Airline US Open Series Bonus Challenge.

The 2007 US Open saw the largest payout in tennis history. Roger Federer, the men's singles champion, collected \$2.4 million, which included \$1 million in bonus prize money for winning both the US Open and the Emirates Airline US Open Series. That total edges out the \$2.3 million—\$1.8 million in US Open prize money and \$500,000 in bonus prize money—won in 2011 by Novak Djokovic, the men's singles champion and the Series runner-up.

In 2010, Kim Clijsters matched her 2005 record for the biggest paycheck in the history of women's professional sports, at \$2.2 million. Clijsters earned that figure in 2010 for winning the US Open and finishing second in the Emirates Airline US Open Series, thus adding \$500,000 in bonus prize money to the \$1.7 million in prize money she earned as the women's singles champion. In 2005, Clijsters took home \$2.2 million for winning the US Open and Series titles. That year, Series winners earned double their prize money at the US Open; the second-place finishers a 50 percent bonus and the third-place finishers earned a 25 percent increase. (For the first year of the Emirates Airline US Open Series, the champions earned a 50 percent bonus at the US Open while the second-place and third-place finishers in the Series received 25 percent more and 10 percent more, respectively.)
