

Arthur Ashe Essay

I believe Arthur Ashe did numerous great things in his life. I think that being the first African American male to win the 1968 United States Open (US) was a great accomplishment. However, I believe he used the win to achieve greater goals. Arthur Ashe achieved superb accomplishments which helped other people.

I believe his founding of the National Junior Tennis and Learning organization (NJTL) after his big win is an example.
