ADULT SERVICE AWARDS

Adaptive Tennis Community Service Award	October 21st: Applications due. National USTA Adaptive Tennis staff, selected committee members, and Executive Director liaison review applications and select the recipient. October 25th: Recipient is notified. Late January / Early February: Award presented at Community Tennis Development Workshop.
Barbara Williams Leadership Award	Mid September: Nomination forms sent out to Sections. Late October: Nominations due to Awards Committee. Mid / Late November: Recipient selected and notified. March / April: Award presented at Luncheon during USTA Annual Meeting.
Brad Parks Award	1 st week in January: Nomination forms go out. End of January: Application deadline. Early February: Announcement. March / April: Award presented at Luncheon during USTA Annual Meeting.
Eve Kraft Community Service Award	May 1st: Applications due to national office. Late January / Early February: Award presented at Community Tennis Development Workshop.
Faculty Emeritus Award	Late August: Award presented at the Tennis Teachers Conference.
President's Award	Nominations may be made at any time.
Ralph W. Westcott USTA Family of the Year Award	Mid September: Nomination forms sent to the sections. Late October: Nominations due to Awards Committee. Mid / Late November: The family is selected and notified. March / April: Award presented at Luncheon during USTA Annual Meeting.
Recreational Coaches Awards	Late August: Presentation at the Tennis Teachers Conference.
Samuel Hardy Award	The honorees are selected by a committee appointed by the chairman of the International Tennis Hall of Fame. Selection is completed prior to the USTA Annual Meeting.
Seniors' Service Award	November: Letter sent out with nomination form to Sectional Executive Directors and Adult/Senior Competition staff asking for nominations. Mid-January: Nominations are due to the USTA Adult/Senior Competition Staff Coordinator, who forwards them to the Awards Committee made up of the A/S Competition Chair and the two Vice Chairs for their vote. (If any one of them has been nominated, the Chair will appoint a designee.) End of January: Nominations are tabulated, and the recipient is selected. March / April: Award presented at Luncheon during USTA Annual Meeting.
Service Bowl Award	April: A letter is sent to past Service Bowl recipients for nominations. June: deadline for nominations. June: deadline to receive final vote. Votes are tabulated. September: Award presented at Breakfast during USTA Semiannual Meeting.
Star Fish Award	Late August: Award presented at the Community Tennis Development Workshop.
Super Senior Service Award	The deadline to receive nominations is July 1.
Tennis Educational Merit Awards for Men and Women	Mid-October: Applications are sent to USTA Sections, USTA, USPTR and International Tennis Hall of Fame Board of Directors. Mid-November: Nomination deadline. Early January: Committee selects recipient. Early February: Recipients are notified. March / April: Award presented at Samuel Hardy Luncheon during USTA Annual Meeting.
