

Winter/Spring 2012 Schedule of Play

All matches will be played on Sunday afternoons with start times of either 1:00 or 2:30.

Beginner Divisions (12-18 & Under)

Matches will be played February 12th, 26th, March 4th, April 1st, 15th and 29th. The End-of-Season Tournament will be May 20th.

Intermediate Divisions (12-18 & Under)

Matches will be played February 19th, 26th, March 25th, April 1st and April 22nd.

Advanced Divisions (12-18 & Under)

Matches will be played February 19th, 26th, March 25th, April 22nd and April 29th.

* The number of match days may change based on the number of teams registered in each division. Season schedules will be available the week prior to the start of play.

USTA Texas JTT Spring Sectional Championships for the 14 and 18 & Under Advanced divisions will be announced at a later date. Sectionals for the 12 & Under Intermediate; the 14 & Under Beginner and Intermediate and 18 & Under Intermediate divisions will be held May 19th-20th at John Newcombe's Tennis Ranch.

It promotes social skills and important values by fostering a spirit of cooperation and unity, as well as individual self growth. It is a fun environment for kids to learn that succeeding is really more about how they play the game - win or lose.

Ages and Divisions Offered

12 & Under

Beginner, Intermediate, Advanced

14 & Under

Beginner, Intermediate, Advanced

18 & Under

Beginner, Intermediate, Advanced

Beginner - (8 ZAT points or fewer) players with limited tournament experience

Intermediate - (9 or more ZAT points) players participating in local and ZAT tournaments

Advanced - players qualified to play in Champ and Super Champ level tournaments

Format of Play

12 & Under Beginner and Non-World Format Teams

This is a non-advancing division. Each team match will consist of 6 sets of singles and 1 set of doubles. All will play a 6-game shortened set using no-ad scoring with a tiebreak at 5-5. (The home team will need to reserve 4 courts for the match. Teams will need between 4-6 players per team match.)

**12 & Under, 14 & Under and 18 & Under Intermediate;
14 & Under and 18 & Under Beginner**

Each team match will consist of 1 set of boys' singles, 1 set of girls'

singles, 1 set of boys' doubles, 1 set of girls' doubles and 1 set of mixed doubles. Teams will play 6-game shortened sets using no-ad scoring with a tiebreak at 5-5. (The home team will need to reserve 4 courts for the match. Teams will need a minimum of 3 boys and 3 girls per team match.)

14 & Under and 18 & Under Advanced

Each team match will consist of 1 set of boys' singles, 1 set of girls' single, 1 set of boys' doubles, 1 set of girls' doubles and 1 set of mixed doubles. Teams will play 8-game pro sets using no-ad scoring with a tiebreak at 7-7. (The home team will need to reserve 4 courts for the match. Teams will need a minimum of 3 boys and 3 girls per team match.)

NOTE: In any team match, a player may play a maximum of 2 sets.

JTT Fees

The local league fee is \$25 per player. This includes the online registration fee and End of Season Tournament. This fee does not include instructional or administrative fees assessed at the individual clubs or tennis facilities for their junior programs.

All participants must be members of the USTA. Junior membership fees are \$19* per year and include special benefits and discounts. Visit www.usta.com/membership for more information.

Registration

Registration opens January 2nd. Teams must have the minimum number of players registered by February 3rd to be placed on the league schedule. Teams may continue to register players through March 16th.
