2012 US Open Group Terms and Conditions

Forwarding of order, application and/or group plan payment constitutes agreement to the following terms: Tickets are personal licenses at the sole discretion of the USTA; the USTA retains the right at any time to revoke any group plan or tickets issued thereunder, for any reason, by refunding the balance of the group plan price less event usage at established ticket prices as determined by the USTA in its sole discretion. Transfer or resale of group plans without the express written consent of the USTA is not permissible and will result in recision of any such group plan by return of the group plan price less event usage at established ticket prices. Renewal of any group plan is at the sole discretion of the USTA and the USTA reserves the right for any reason whatsoever not to renew any group plan or to change the seat location previously assigned to any group plan. Upon receipt of tickets, risk of loss or theft of tickets shall pass to group plan holder; the USTA shall not be obligated to admit group plan holders to events unless applicable tickets are presented at such time. All deposits paid for tickets are NON-REFUNDABLE. Completing the requisite paperwork and submitting a deposit does not guarantee an opportunity to purchase tickets. In the event an opportunity to purchase tickets is not made available, the deposit will be refunded. Tickets purchased for the entire tournament (e.g., box and series seats), and complimentary tickets, shall not be entitled to any exchange or refund if a session is cancelled for any reason. Group plan accounts may be in the name of an individual, partnership, corporation or other entity. The name on the account will determine the group plan holder of record with the USTA and may not be changed without the agreement of the USTA. The use of other names on invoices, mailing addresses, checks for payment or otherwise shall have no effect and does not change the identity of the group plan holder of record. Tickets may not be used for advertising, promotion, contests, sweepstakes or other trade purposes without the express written consent of the USTA. The US Open schedule of play, as well as session dates, number of matches and starting times, are subject to change. This document constitutes a contract containing the entire agreement between the parties. This contract is governed by the laws of the State of New York and cannot be modified without the written consent of both parties. The group plan holder has read and understands the terms and conditions of this contract.
