MISCELLANEOUS: Increased Prize Money: The USTA has made a commitment to increase prize money to \$50 million by 2017. This year's prize money increase is \$8.1 million, which will bring the total player compensation to \$33.6 million. The round-by-round prize money breakdown will be available via the Players Only Web page (USOpen.org/playersonly) in mid-July. Upgraded Players Only Web Page: We are working on a new and improved Players Only Web page (USOpen.org/playersonly) that will feature easier navigation, additional features and will be more smartphone and tablet friendly. Be sure to visit the page often for the latest tournament information. Schedule Changes: The US Open has added a day to the tournament schedule for 2013 that will expand Finals Weekend into a four-day event and will impact all five Main Draw events. The Mixed Doubles Final is now scheduled for Friday, the Men's Doubles Final for Sunday and the Men's Singles Final on Monday. Match DVDs Expanded to Select Doubles Matches: For the last several years, the US Open has provided players with a complimentary match DVD for all televised Singles matches played in Arthur Ashe Stadium, Louis Armstrong Stadium, Grandstand and Courts 11, 13 and 17. We are pleased to announce this service is being expanded in 2013 to include all televised Doubles matches played on these courts as well. US Open Online Credential System: Everyone requesting a credential for the 2013 US Open will be required to apply via the US Open Online Credential System. Paper applications will no longer be available or accepted. Those under 18 years of age will also need to submit a secondary form. Online Forms: Players can request a Letter of Invitation or a Wild Card via online forms (pdfs are also available) on the Players Only Web page (USOpen.org/playersonly). The site will continue to include player-related information such as the Player Handbook, fact sheets, transportation details, important dates/deadlines, discount offers and more. Official Order of Play Available Online ONLY: The schedule information phone-in system has been discontinued, so the Official Order of Play will ONLY be available via the Players Only Web page (USOpen.org/playersonly). Microphones in Player Boxes: There will be microphones in the player boxes in Arthur Ashe Stadium as an enhancement for our domestic television viewers. All replays will be shown on a delayed basis and nothing inappropriate/embarrassing will be broadcast. Please advise your guests accordingly. US Open National Playoffs: The winners of the US Open National Playoffs men's and women's singles events will once again receive Wild Cards into the 2013 US Open Qualifying, while winners of the US Open National Playoffs mixed doubles event will receive a Wild Card into the 2013 US Open Mixed Doubles competition. The US Open Mixed Doubles competition will consist of 24 direct acceptances and eight Wild Cards. Proper Use of US Open Credentials and Player Tickets: As part of the ongoing security improvements at the US Open, there will be strict penalties imposed for the improper use of credentials and player tickets.
