Consolation: Non feed-in Championship Consolation Formats Include: First Match losers consolation (FMLC); First Round Losers Consolation (FRLC); Modified Feed-in Championship (MFC); Compass Draw. *This point table is used, for example, for the Compass Draw singles events at all USTA Boys' & Girls' 14 & 12 National Championships (Level 1). It is also the table used for all single elimination doubles events at USTA National Championships (Level 1), USTA National Opens (L2), USTA Regional Tournament (L3), +L1 Eastern Designated Closed SE, and most all Eastern L1, L1B and L2R and L2O tournaments.*

This point table is used, for example, for the singles events Boys' & Girls' 18 & 16 National Championships, USTA National Opens, and USTA Regional Tournaments and +L1 Eastern Designated Closed FIC tournaments. There is no L1A National Ranking Tournament with this draw format.

Table 43: Eastern Bonus Points –

Rewards for Significant Wins. Bonus Points are earned at Eastern tournaments for significant wins (SigW) over the top the 50 players according to the table below. Bonus points are earned for wins in Eastern sanctioned matches ONLY. If a tournament total is not among a player’s best six tournaments, neither the Points per Round nor the Bonus Points will count toward the player’s ranking point total. Bonus points for any Eastern tournament will be based on the tournament start date and the previous months published standing list. For example a December standing list will be used to determine the bonus points for a tournament with a start date in January.

- USTA Zone Team Championships (Level 2)
- USTA Jr. Team Tennis Advanced Division National Championships – U18 & U14 (level 5)

Ranking points earned are based on the position a player is on a team. Any bonus points earned will be added to this total. For example, if a player in position #1 player on the team has four wins at a Level 2 tournament, and one of the wins results earns 50 bonus points, the player will earn 250 total ranking points for the tournament (50 points x 4 wins+50 bonus points).
