Tennis To Debut At 2014 Arnold Sports Festival

COLUMBUS, Ohio – The **Arnold Sports Festival** and the United States Tennis Association/Midwest Section have partnered to bring **Tennis** to the Arnold Sports Festival for the first time in 2014. The USTA/Midwest Section will conduct tennis demonstrations and offer open play from Friday, February 28 through Sunday, March 2 in Rooms E150/E151 at the Greater Columbus Convention Center. Several different types of tennis activities are planned, giving attendees the opportunity to find a healthy, new way to get in shape and burn calories. The festival also includes two special competitive events highlighting junior tennis; the first-annual Arnold Tennis Championships Junior Jamboree (grades 6-8) and the first annual Arnold Sports Festival Tennis Play Day (grades 2-5). Both events will take place Saturday, March 1 at the Scarborough East Tennis & Fitness Center in Columbus, Ohio.

"We are excited to bring Tennis to the Arnold Sports Festival for the first time in 2014," said Jim Lorimer, Arnold Sports Festival co-founder. "The Arnold Tennis Championships will offer an excellent competitive outlet for junior tennis players and options for interested youth to learn more about this great Olympic sport."

The 2014 Arnold Sports Festival will be held Feb. 27-March 2 in Columbus, Ohio and surrounding communities. The Arnold Sports Festival will again attract 175,000 sports and fitness fans to watch 18,000 athletes compete in 50 sports and events, including 13 Olympic events.

The three-day Arnold Fitness EXPO features 700 booths of the latest in sports equipment, apparel and nutrition and two stages that host unique, non-stop competitions and entertainment. The Arnold Fitness EXPO will be held Feb. 28-March 2, 2014 at the Greater Columbus Convention Center.
