Thanks for all that you have done, and for all that you will do for USTA Texas tennis. I look forward to meeting each of you.

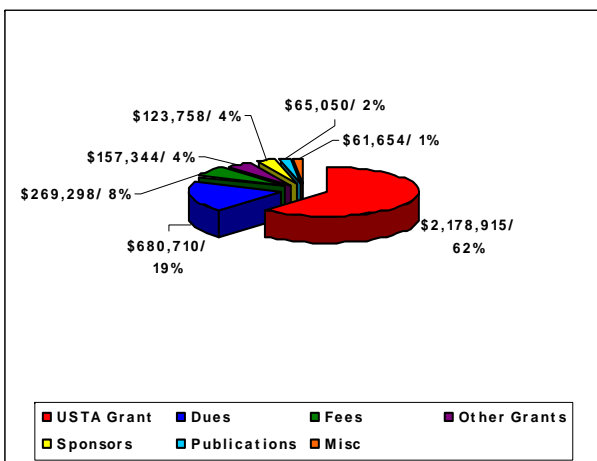

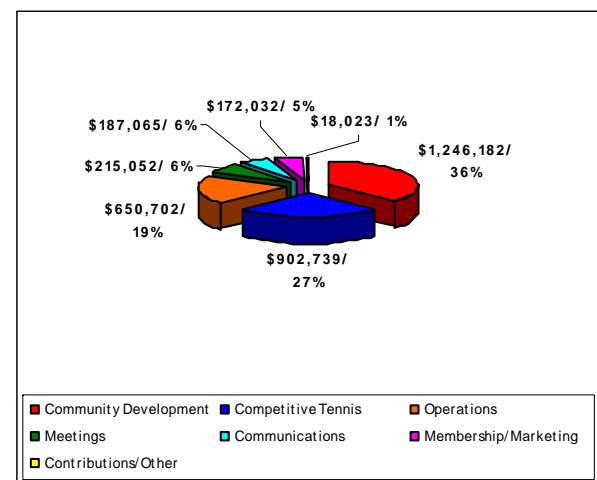

2010 Highlights

- Texas Membership reached 53,140 USTA Texas members and an all time high of 572 organization members.
- The Community Tennis Association Expansion Plan continued to move forward. The 17 'qualified' CTA's began taking the second of four steps by bringing Junior Team Tennis under their umbrella.
- Marketing signed its first international sponsor, Sportsworld UK.
- Texas' three certified USTA Regional Training Centers (Austin Tennis Academy, John Newcombe Tennis Ranch and T Bar M of Dallas) hosted six Regional Player Development Camps focused on players ages 8-12.
- Corpus Christi played host in June to the nation's largest QuickStart Training, with well over 100 participants from the City of Corpus Christi Summer Latch Key Program taking part.
- NJTL Kids' Days were hosted in Houston, Dallas and San Angelo. The NJTL Tennis Leadership Camp again took place at the University of Texas at Austin with 20 participants from Texas.
- Cody Stewart of Dallas won the Boys 16 & Under division in the National Arthur Ashe Essay Contest.
- The Austin Tennis Academy Dream Team placed second at the Jr. Team Tennis National Championships in the 18 & Under Advanced division and the Tennis Soldiers of Southlake placed fourth in the 14 & Under Intermediate division.
- Texas' USTA League teams had tremendous success at Nationals, as the Dallas 8.0 Mixed Doubles and the Dallas 3.5 Men were crowned as champions. Others placing at Nationals included the Fort Worth 9.0 Mixed Doubles (second), Dallas 4.5 Men (third), Fort Worth 3.5 Senior Men (fourth), Lubbock 4.0 Men (third), Houston 4.5 Senior Ladies (fourth) and the Wichita Falls 7.0 Mixed Doubles (third).
- The inaugural Randy Snow Wheelchair Award was presented to Carlos Turic at our annual meeting in honor of this tennis legend.
- More than 30 Texas colleges and over 100 co-ed teams participated in Tennis on Campus Regional Tournaments.
