The USTA Texas Section offers support to Community Tennis Associations as well as other organizations dedicated to growing tennis in Texas. Eligible organizations may receive financial and/or equipment assistance.

Things to Consider

- ... USTA Texas Grants are a privilege, not a right
- ... Applicants must demonstrate responsibility and frugality
- ... Organizations and programs must show self-sufficiency and sustainability for the future
- ... Grants are intended for promotions and development; not for staffing purposes
- ... Grant reports are required as requested

Grow the Game Grant

- ... Available to:
 - o CTAs
 - o Coaches and Pros
 - o Clubs
 - o Parks and Recreation departments
 - o Service organizations
- ... Program Oriented
- ... Intended for program development; not salaries and stipends
- ... Maximum Grant: \$2,500

CTA Start Up Grant

- ... One time grant for communities beginning a Community Tennis Association.
- ... Used for general start up costs such as:
 - ... Website development
 - ... Incorporation fees
 - ... Kick off event
- ... Maximum Grant: \$1,000

CTA Partnership Grant

- ... Available to all registered and approved CTAs
- ... Supports annual CTA operations including:
 - o Website maintenance
 - o Board development
 - o Volunteer recruitment and retention
 - o Fundraising
 - o Professional development and training
- ... Maximum Grant: \$7,500

GRANTS

School Grant

- ... Used to support schools and districts that implement the USTA School Curriculum
- ... Schools must be organizational members to receive funding
- ... Physical Educators implementing curriculum must attend USTA School In-service

Texas Facility Funding

- ... Available to facilities looking to modify or build tennis courts with a plan to accommodate 10 and Under Tennis.
- ... Includes:
 - o Painting blended lines to convert 78' courts to 36' and 60' QuickStart courts
 - o Resurfacing 78' courts
- ... Used when modifying 1 or 2 courts
- ... Matching Grant: Section will match funds invested by facility up to \$10,000

National Facility Funding

- ... Available to facilities looking to modify or build tennis courts
- ... Used when modifying 2 or more courts
- ... Category 1 Grant:
 - o Matched dollar for dollar up to \$4,000
 - o Blended Line and Conversion Grant
 - o Playground Line Grant
- ... Collegiate Line Grant:
 - o USTA will fund 100% for blended lines on collegiate courts up to \$4,000
- ... Category 2 Grant:
 - o Up to 20% of projected cost capped at \$35,000
- ... Category 3 Grant:
 - o Up to 20% of project cost capped at \$50,000
