2014 Super Champ Tournament Formats

<u>USTA Texas Feed In Consolation through the Quarterfinal Round – January, April, May, September and November</u>

Singles A Draw – Main Draw plays full two-out-of-three set matches except for 12 & under divisions which will play 10 point match tiebreak in lieu of third set. Consolation Draw plays 10 point match tiebreak in lieu of the third set. Feed In Consolation through the Quarterfinal Round. Play-off for 3rd and 4th place.

Singles B Draw – Main and Consolation Draw plays 10 point match tiebreak in lieu of the third set. Feed In Consolation through the Quarterfinal Round. Play-off for 3rd and 4th place.

Doubles A and B Draw –8 game Pro-Sets with single elimination.

USTA Texas Feed In Consolation through the Quarterfinal Round - July and August

Singles A & B Draw – Main and Consolation Draw plays 10 point match tiebreak in lieu of the third set. Feed In Consolation through the Quarterfinal Round. Play-off for 3rd and 4th place.

Doubles A and B Draw –8 game Pro-Sets with single elimination.

USTA Texas Excellence

Singles – All Super Champ players are eligible. In each age group there will be an A draw, B draw and multiple C draws as needed. There will also be a D draw. The A draw will be the top 16 players, and the B draw will be the next 16 players. The C draw will consist of all other players, equally split into draws of 16 (maximum). The D draw will consist of the overflow players from the C draws and will have a minimum of 4 players. A, B and C draws will be compass draws. The D draw will be a round robin or a compass draw depending on the number of players. All matches will be best of two-out-of-three sets. All draws will be adjusted up until the first match begins as long as a match needs to be created. If a match needs to be created, then adjustments will be made up until the previous Thursday at 6:00pm. No adjustments will be made after play begins.

Doubles - All Super Champ players are eligible. In each age group there will be an A draw and multiple B draws as needed. There will also be a C draw. The A draw will be the top 16 teams. The B draws will consist of all other teams, equally split into draws of 16 (maximum). The C draw will consist of the overflow teams from the B draws and will have a minimum of 4 teams. A and B draws will be compass draws. The C draw will be a round robin or a compass draw depending on the number of teams. All matches will play a 10 point match tiebreak in lieu of the third set. All draws will be adjusted up until

the first match begins as long as a match needs to be created. If a match needs to be created, then adjustments will be made up until the previous Thursday at 6:00pm. No adjustments will be made after play begins.

USTA Texas First Match Loser Consolation

Singles A & B Draw – Main and Consolation Draw plays 10 point match tiebreak in lieu of the third set. First Match Loser Consolation. Play-off for 3rd and 4th place.

Doubles A and B Draw –8 game Pro-Sets with single elimination.

Texas Section Grand Slam Feed In Consolation through Quarterfinal Round

Singles Draws – Main Draw plays full two-out-of-three set matches. Consolation Draw plays 10 point match tiebreak in lieu of the third set. Feed In Consolation through the Quarterfinal Round. Play-off for 3^{rd} and 4^{th} place.

Doubles Draws – Single elimination. 8 game Pro-Sets through the Quarterfinal Round and full two-out-of-three set matches for the Semifinal and Finals.

2014 Super Champ Changes – Frequently Asked Questions

• Why are there so many changes for 2014?

In order to align with the 2014 National changes, the Texas Section has made adjustments to the Super Champ tournament structure, format, scheduling and point tables to ensure the best possible competitive experience for our players. The new tournament structure and format provides more matches against like competition and the best opportunity for National points. The tournament schedule also reduces the number of missed school days. The new point tables will provide a more accurate ranking system by adjusting the values for each level of tournament.

Why is it so important to play in the section with the National changes starting in 2014?

Access to USTA National Championships will be primarily through Sectional quota, and access to Closed USTA Regional Tournaments will be exclusively by Sectional quota. This places an increased importance on achieving excellence at the Sectional level before advancing to Regional and National competition.

• Which Texas Section tournaments count for National points?

Starting on January 1, 2014 all USTA Sections will have six Sectional tournaments that count for National points. 2 – Level 3 National point tournaments and 4 – Level 4 National point tournaments.

How have the tournament names changed?

Previously all Super Champ tournaments were either named Super Champ Major Zones, Excellence, Grand Slam or junior other tournaments. Now Super Champ tournaments are named Level 3, Level 4, Super Champ Major Zones, Excellence, Grand Slam or junior other tournaments. All Super Champ tournaments except for junior other tournaments will be referred to as Super Champ Designated Tournaments.

• Did ranking requirements for Super Champ Standings change?

No, ranking requirements remain the same - a combined ranking of a player's best five singles results and best five doubles results from the 13 tournaments designated on the Super Champ tournament schedule and / or junior other tournaments in a twelve month rolling period will be used to calculate standings.

How will this affect the age up process?

First of all there are no changes to the regulations for Super Champ age up — still BG12-14 top 35% or ranked 35 or better and BG16 top 35% of the Super Champ Standing List published the month prior to aging up. Although the point charts are changing in January, all players have the same opportunity for points. If a players ages up within the first six months of 2014, depending on the player's ranking, it may be important for the player to play in their natural age division to secure their ranking within the top 35% or to be ranked within the top 35.

Are endorsement requirements changing in 2014?

Yes, the changes to endorsement are underlined below.

How to become Endorsed?

- a) Players must complete at least one of the 13 Super Champ Designated Tournaments in order to be endorsed.
- b) Endorsement Lists are generated based on the Super Champs Standing List and will include the following players:
 - i) U.S. citizens and certain aliens (see Friend at Court)
 - ii) Players who are within the quota of the older age division will be added to the top of the younger endorsement list for which they are age eligible.
- c) The number of players listed in ii) above may fluctuate annually, depending on Texas' allocated endorsement
- d) Any "elite player", as defined by the following criteria: 1) player has a top 250 ITF ranking, and/or 2) player has a top 25 USTA National Ranking; who cannot meet their endorsement requirements, may apply for a waiver to the Director of Competitive Tennis and the Chairman of the Junior Tennis Council. Please contact the Section office for this Elite Player Waiver Application. If the waiver is granted, the player will be added to the top of the endorsement list.

What will be the Bonus Point structure in 2014?

Bonus points are awarded for wins in singles events, over the top 75 players who are listed on the

Bonus Points List published the month prior to the start of the tournament.

Which matches do bonus points apply to?

Bonus points will apply to retirements and walkovers. Bonus points will not apply to withdrawals, defaults or byes.

What Super Champ tournaments are Out-of-Section players eligible to compete in?

March, July, August and December Super Champ Major Zones.

• Have seeding requirements changed?

No, seeding remains the same for all Super Champ tournaments – based on the most current Super Champ Standing List only.

• Are there any changes with doubles registration?

No, registration for doubles in all Super Champ tournaments remains the same. Players may register with or without a partner. Those registered without a partner will be paired with another registered doubles player based on the order of the current Standings list, if a partner is available.

• Why have entry fees for Super Champ Major Zones increased?

There has been no increase of Super Champ entry fees for 7 years and the new tournament formats create more opportunity to play thus increasing costs for courts, officials, balls, and tournament staff.

- \$45 Regular First Match Loser Consolation Super Champ Major Zones
- \$55 3 day Feed In Consolation through the Quarterfinal Round
- \$65 4 day Feed In Consolation through the Quarterfinal Round
- \$80 Summer Grand Slam with Feed In Consolation through the Quarterfinal Round
- \$55 Singles Excellence with Compass Draw
- \$30 per player Doubles Excellence with Compass Draw

• Will there be 3rd place play-offs for Feed In Consolation and First Match Loser Consolation formats?

Yes, in all Feed In Consolation and First Match Loser Consolation draws a play-off for 3rd and 4th place will occur. This play-off will give players the opportunity for more Sectional and National points.

• Any special consideration for winning B draws?

Yes, in four tournaments only - winners of the B draws will be moved to the A draw in the next immediate SCMZ they are registered for (SCMZs are only March, July, August and December).

• How were the B draw points for Level 3 and 4 Super Champ tournaments with an A draw of 64 calculated?

Winners of the B draw receive points which are equivalent to finishing 13-16th place in the A draw. The rankings of the players in the B draw are outside the top 64 which reflects in the level of competition.
