Local player wins Corpus Christi tennis tournament

CORPUS CHRISTI, Texas – On May 4, Carlos Flores of Brownsville won the Corpus Christi Championship Major Zone and qualified for the super championship level.

Flores, seeded fourth, defeated number one seed Juan Torres of Mission in a tiebreaker, 1-6, 6-3, 10-6, to win the boys 12's singles final.

To qualify for the next level, super championship, a player must either win a Championship Major Zone or accumulate 64 points from his or her best four consecutive tournaments of the year.

Championship Major Zones are competitive tournaments sponsored by the USTA. They are offered once a month in different regions of Texas. Players compete to qualify for the highest level, super championship.

The next Championship Major Zone is July 7, and the next Super Championship Major Zone is July 4.
