



POINT PENALTY & CONDUCT REPORT

- ❖ **Point Penalties** will be imposed against a player for their or their associates' (parent, relative, coach or other person) unsportsmanlike conduct during a tournament such as the following:
 - Unreasonable delays after the warm-up period, between points and when changing ends, and otherwise unreasonably delaying a match
 - Visible or audible profanity or obscenity
 - Abuse of racket, balls or equipment
 - Verbal or physical abuse of a player or official
 - Coaching by any accompanying person -coaching is considered to be communication, advice or instruction of any kind, audible or visible to a player.
 - Failure to follow the instructions of an official
 - Abusive conduct by a player or a person associated with a player including retaliatory calls and unsportsmanlike conduct that is abusive or detrimental to the sport
 - Being overruled on more than 2 line calls in one set

All of the above apply to conduct during all matches (main draw, consolation, qualifying, and doubles), during tournament activities and at tournament facilities.

Violations are penalized as follows:

- First offense.....**Point**
- Second offense.....**Game**
- Third offense..... **Default**

- ❖ **Conduct** such as the following should also be recorded on this form
 - Tournament Director or Official was requested to resolve line call questions
 - Tournament Director or Official was requested to resolve score dispute
 - Tournament Director or Official overruled a player more than twice
 - Tournament Director or Official was alerted to alleged coaching by a player's associate
