



2012 Northern Oregon Senior League Playoff Draws September 12, 2011

There will be no playoffs for the 3.0 men, 4.5 men and 4.5 women as they are playing double round robins and there is no reason to have them play each other again. The top team will go automatically to sectionals and if we have any wild cards here in Northern Oregon the second place team will attend.

3.5 men and 4.0 men have two flights; they have 8-10 teams in each flight. I am using a two flight draw. Six teams will be invited to local league playoffs.

3.0, 3.5 and 4.0 women have three flights. Eight teams will be invited to local league playoffs as follows: The top two teams from each flight plus two wildcards. The wildcards will be the top two third place teams based on USTA League tiebreak procedures. When flights have a different number of teams, to adjust for the different number of matches played during the season, the average of total match wins divided by total matches played will be used to determine the best records. Using the color coded chart on the next page, a team will not play a team from their same flight in the first round. However, if a club has two teams participating in playoffs they may play each other in the first round.

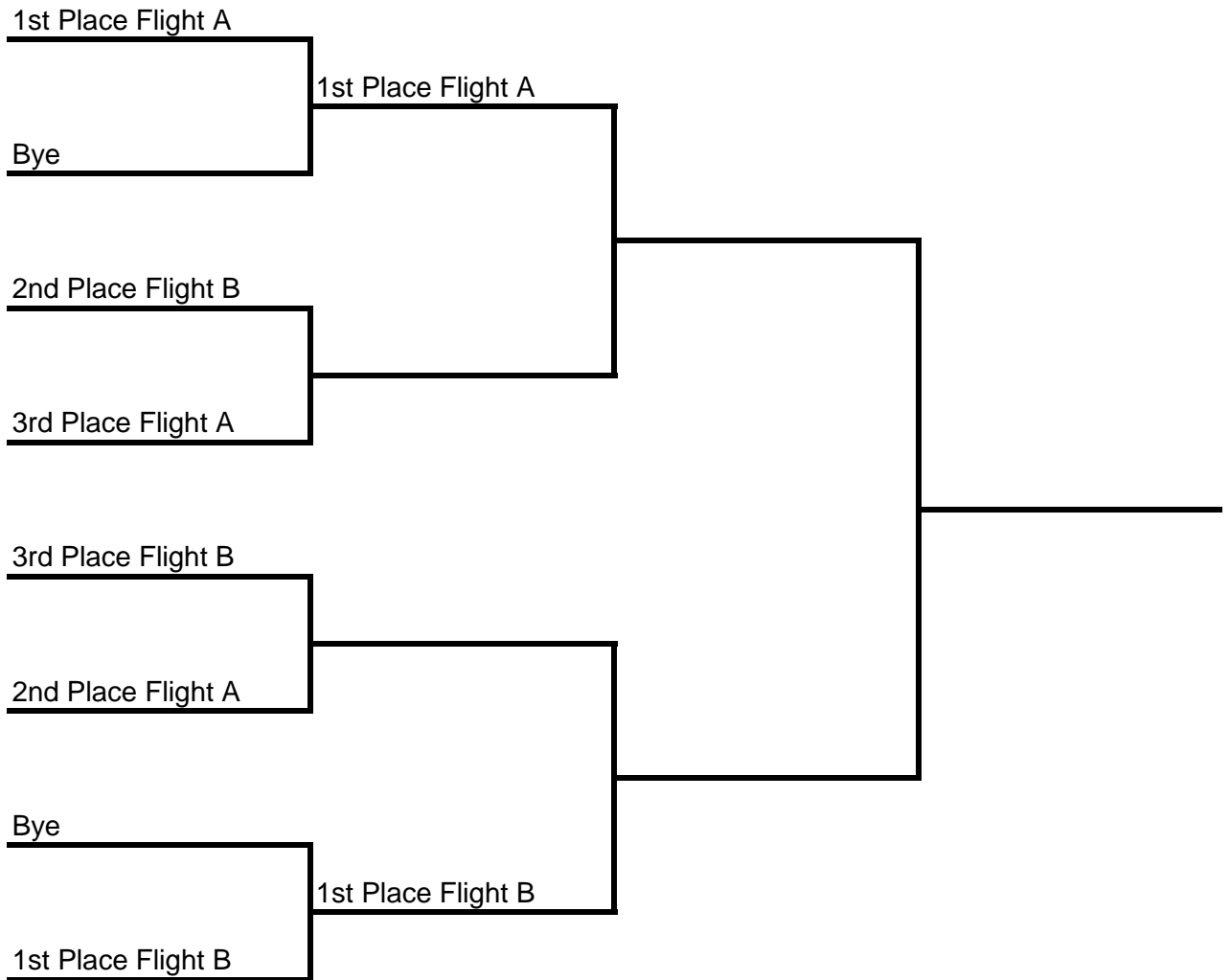

2 Flight Draw layout

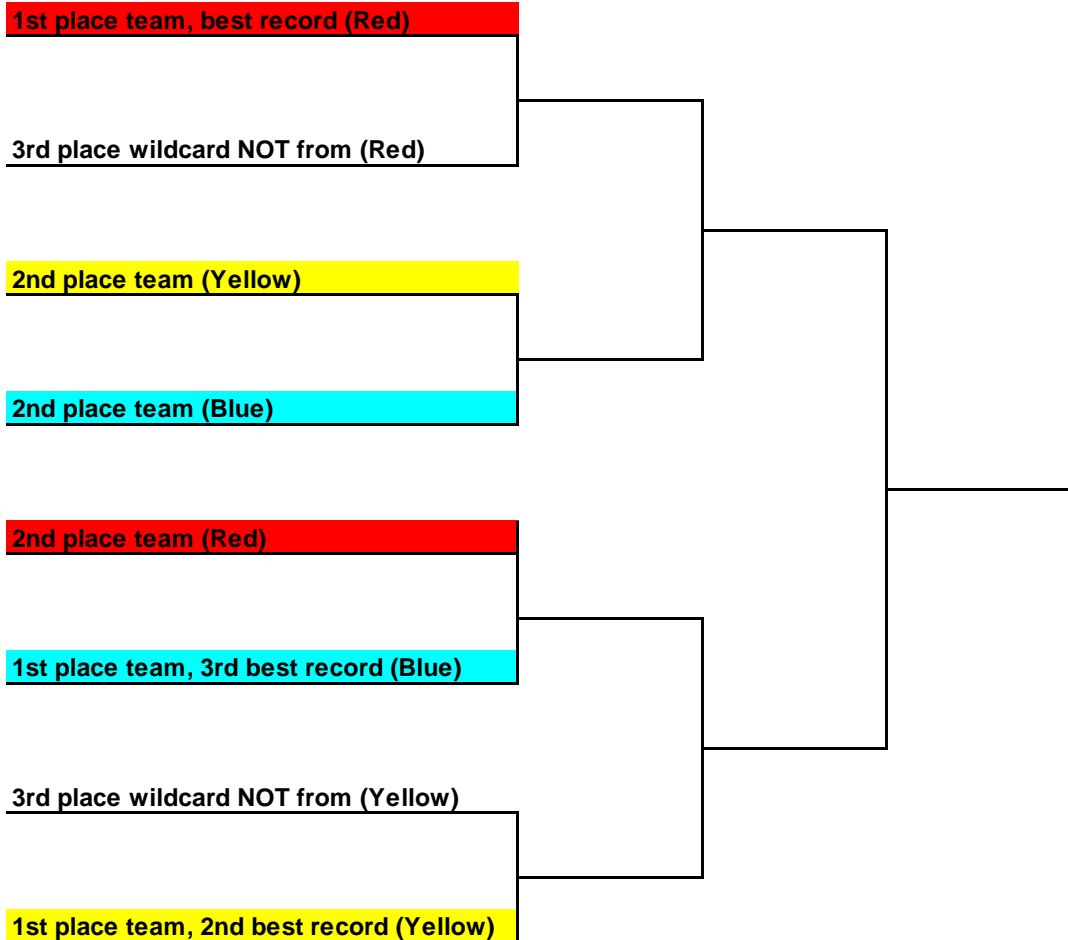
3.5, 4.0 Men



Three Flight Draws

3.0, 3.5 & 4.0 Women

(Red flight) 1st place team w/ best record
(Yellow flight) 1st place team w/ 2nd best record
(Blue flight) 1st place team w/ 3rd best record



Seeding will be based on "Best Record" format. Wildcards will not be seeded.
All teams will be placed in draws to accomodate a "Non same team 1st round play".

Example for a 3 flight draw:

- (1) #1 A/B/C (best record)
- (2) #1 A/B/C (second best record)
- (3) #1 A/B/C (third best record)
- (4) #2 A/B/C (best record)
- (5) #2 A/B/C (second best record)
- (6) #2 A/B/C (third best record)
- Wildcard #1 (#3 A/B/C best record)
- Wildcard #2 (#3 A/B/C second best record)
