## All-American Final At The Atlanta Tennis Championships

The inaugural final of the Atlanta Tennis Championships will be won by an American. The question is whether it will be hometown Georgia Bulldog and No. 2 seed John Isner, or Mardy Fish, the four-time ATP World Tour titlist and No. 6 seed at the Atlanta Tennis Championships.

Yesterday afternoon John Isner saved seven break points and needed nearly two and a half hours to outlast South African Kevin Anderson 6-3, 6-7(7), 6-3. The victory advanced Isner into his fourth ATP World Tour final of the year with the previous three coming in Auckland (site of his first ATP Tour title), Memphis, and Belgrade.

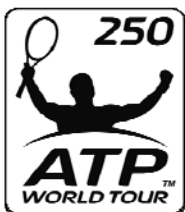
In the Saturday evening session, Mardy Fish defeated long-time friend and top seed Andy Roddick 7-6(5), 6-3 to advance to his third ATP World Tour final in his last four ATP World Tour events. Dating back to his opening match at Newport, Fish has won nine straight matches and is arguably playing the best tennis of his career.

In 2009 in San Jose, Fish defeated Isner in the round of 16, which is the only time they have met in their careers. Today there is a lot more at stake as an ATP World Tour title is on the line and the winner will go down in the history books as the first ever champion of the Atlanta Tennis Championships.
