## The Champ Returns

The last player to win an ATP World Tour tournament in the city of Atlanta was Andy Roddick in 2001. He defeated current Atlanta Tennis Championships' No. 7 seed Xavier Malisse 6-2, 6-4 to win the Verizon Tennis Challenge and now, nearly a decade later, he returns to defend his crown.

Wednesday saw four Americans move into the quarterfinals with three of them needing three sets to advance. Taylor Dent opened play, knocking out the No. 4 seed Horacio Zeballos 6-0 in the third. The No. 2 seed John Isner followed Dent, and prevailed after saving two match points against qualifier Gilles Muller to win 4-5, 7-6(6), 7-6(7). Michael Russell upset Rainer Schuettler after falling in the first 6-1 and ending the night was Mardy Fish who defeated hometown favorite Robby Ginepri 6-1, 7-5.

Today begins with the first ever US Open National Playoffs - Men's Championship. In the main draw, the lineup is possibly the strongest lineup Atlanta has seen since April of 1994 when the city watched Agassi, Chan, Sampras, and Martin all compete on the same day. The No. 1 seed Andy Roddick will begin the day with his first singles appearance and end the session playing doubles with Mardy Fish. Sandwiched between Roddick's two matches, James Blake and John Isner will attempt to advance to the semifinals of the doubles draw and Lleyton Hewitt, who has won 27 ATP World Tour titles since his initial visit to Atlanta, will follow them when he faces off against Lukas Lacko.

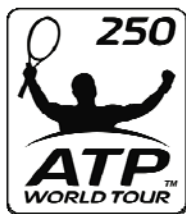
