The following is a breakdown of sponsorship/donation opportunities for the 115th Annual GPTC/Oregon Tennis Championships. This tournament is the primary fundraiser for the non-profit organization, Greater Portland Tennis Council (GPTC). This professional and amateur tennis tournament attracts players from all over the United States. Sites for the tournament include: Tualatin Hills Tennis Center in Beaverton, West Hills Racquet and Fitness Club in Portland and Mountain Park Racquet Club in Lake Oswego.

Outstanding Pacific Northwest Pros participate in this event along with top collegiate players. Often there are international and future star professionals in the field. Previous entrants have included NCAA Division number one ranked players in Men's and Women's collegiate rankings, Jonathan Stark, past world's #1 doubles player and most recently Oregon's own Travis Parrott who has won a US Open Grand Slam title. Several previous participants have been ranked on the United State Top 500 ranking list. Additionally, local and regional senior players participate alongside nationally ranked seniors in the 30-90 year old age categories. There are over 500 participants in the tournament and over 1000 spectators during the event. \$15,000 in total prize money is given out to the participants, making us one of the highest paying tennis tournaments in the Pacific Northwest.

The GPTC has supported and promoted local tennis for the past twenty years. The GPTC's primary focus is on youth tennis programs. We mentor and train ball kids for our tournament and a number of our ball kids have received scholarships to work the US Open. Several of our ball kids qualified to participate in the Davis Cup Finals in Portland in 2007. Over the last few years, the GPTC has given over \$7,000 to local high schools to support their tennis programs. In addition, the GPTC supports "T" for Tennis which provides group lessons to children in local Headstart programs. GPTC has over 20 volunteers who teach these lessons to over 650 kids each year. Also the GPTC supports and provides funds toward the 10 and under Jr. Team Tennis Leagues in the local area.

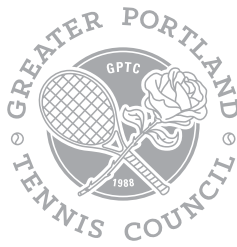
